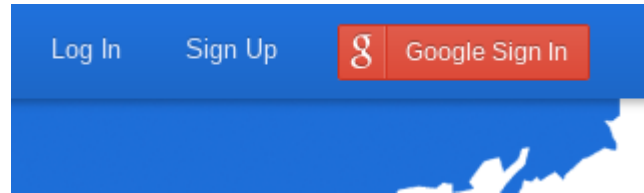

- At first, make your set visible to everyone. However, you might want to change this if you create classes and want to track the class progress as a whole.
 - Images can only be added if you upgrade to Teacher, which costs \$25/year.
 - “Quick Switch” allows for easy selection of English, but other languages are available.

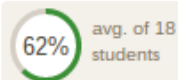
Tracking Progress

Note: Some features are only available if you have paid for the upgrade. You can, however, still see who has been studying even with the free version.

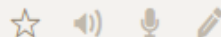
View progress by Ms. Stegall English 9 in the past year
