Beginning Steps

Setting Up Class Roster

After successful sign in click on the roster icon



- Two options to register your class
 - Register New Student (allows one at a time)
 - o Bulk Register
 - Option 1 is computer generated
 - More suited for older students
 - Option 2 is user generated
 - Better for younger students

Student usage

- Students will enter the name of their school when reaching the login screen
 - Once in:
 - Students click on the icon of the subject desired
 - All subjects except for writing, stories and test prep
 - Students will take a pre-assessment
 - Tests when end when assessment is complete
 - Lessons will be assigned at completion of test
 - According to test results

Checking Students' Progress

- Click on the icon you want to see progress for
- One option is to select tabs on the top of the screen for subjects
- Another option is to select the actual student's s name you want to check on

Assigning lessons/tests

- Click on the icon for the subject desired
 - Go to the lessons tab
 - Click on assign lessons
 - When there, you can assign by individual students or groups
 - Not all subjects have lessons to assign
 - Go to placement tab
 - Check the box next to the student's name that says "Assign new test"
