

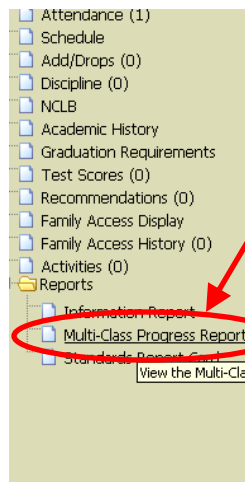
How to View ALL Grades for your Students

1. Go to “My Gradebook” and select a class, then click on the boy/girl icon next to the student’s name, as shown at right:

2. In the student information screen that appears, in the menu on the left hand side of the screen, click on “Multi-Class Progress Report”, as shown at left:

If you don’t see this option, left-click once on the “Reports” folder.

3. On the next screen, select “View Report for Selected Student”

4. After the report queues and appears, you will be able to view and print the current grades entered for each class the student is enrolled in. You will see a letter grades and a summary of each class’ grade categories (Assignments, Quizzes, Tests, etc.), not every daily score entry for every class.

GHS Advisory: Some students might appear as being enrolled in 2 advisories (mainly freshman and spec. ed. students, I think). So be aware, 5 “classes” might show up for some students.
